KENYA

We are now heavily involved in Turkana in the north of Kenya and have paired up with an organisation called KAPADO. We are developing a long term educational and wider development plan for the region.



We have now built a nursery school and have plans for another three, a secondary school and fresh water provision. The first school is in the picture below - it doesn't look like much but there is NOTHING else there!



LESOTHO

The latest Burnaby Blue expedition that was carried out by the Household cavalry reached Lesotho in July 2008 and did £16,000 worth of work in the Thuso School for AIDS orphans with money donated by the BBF. A huge amount was done including major renovation work and the building of a secure perimeter fence. HRH Prince Harry came along as part of the team

We have recently started discussions with the wife of the German Ambassador in Baku. There is still much therapy work to be done at the Saray orphanage and we are looking at how we can continue to help.
